

## Application Instructions for Integrative Biology Graduate Summer 2011 Research Awards

The IB Department will award summer research grants to graduate students who are within normative time, passed their qualifying exam, and have a current annual review on file. Amount of awards will depend on fund availability and number of applications. We hope to be able to give out awards in the range of \$1.5K-\$3K. This year the awards will come from the Gray Endowment, Henry Fellowship, Beim Fellowship, Margaret Long Scholarship, Jane Wiley Scholarship, Umbson Fellowship, Resetko Scholarship, and the Smith Endowment.

- ◆ *Beim Fellowship* - to support the research of students whose dissertation research consists mainly, if not exclusively, of field research.
- ◆ *Henry Fellowship* - to support the research of students whose research is in the area of human physiology.
- ◆ *Margaret Long Scholarship* – to support the research of women students whose research is in the area of human physiology.
- ◆ *Gray Endowment* - to support IB grad student research
- ◆ *Smith Endowment* – for expenses incurred while working at established marine stations
- ◆ *Jane Wiley Scholarship* - to support students with a burning desire to study the life sciences
- ◆ *Umbson Fellowship* - to support basic research by students in physiology or anatomy
- ◆ *Resetko Scholarships* - to support students in the Division of Biological Sciences

### **To be eligible applicants must have, as of May 2, 2011:**

- ◆ passed the qualifying exam
- ◆ been in the program for no more than five years (entered after Fall 2005)
- ◆ a 2010-11 Annual Review on file (if unsure check with Mei)

### **Please submit the following documents (in sequential order):**

1. The application form (found on IB website at <http://ib.berkeley.edu/student/grad/forms/index.php>)
2. A summary of your summer 2011 research plan – not more than 400 words, at least 11pt font
3. A research budget capped at \$3K (please use budget form on the website). Include research related expenses but not salary or local residence living expenses. Travel to field sites or scientific conferences and associated living expenses are eligible budgetary expenses. You must be presenting a poster or talk at the conference. **The budget form requires your faculty advisor's signature.**
