Application for IB H196B: Integrative Biology Honors Program

**IB H196B: The Integrative Biology Honors Program** is intended for advanced undergraduates wishing to receive the second semester of honors credit for independent research projects. To apply for IB H196B, the research project must be rigorous and H196A must have been completed.

## **ELIGIBILITY**:

- Be a declared IB major
- Have at least a 3.3 GPA overall and in the IB major
- Have completed IB H196A

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Meet with PI and obtain PI signature by end of Week 3.
- Meet with IB Faculty Sponsor and obtain signature by end of Week 4. See below for information.
- Obtain CCN from IB USSO (3060 VLSB) enroll in the course via Telebears by the end of Week 5.

**CREDIT:** This is a 3-unit, letter-graded course, and assumes an average of 9 hours of work/week. To receive honors, a thesis must be submitted to the PI and faculty sponsor at the end of the semester, and the student must participate in the Cal Day poster session. Only three units of honors credit (H196A or H196B) may be applied towards elective credit for the IB major.

**SPONSORSHIP of IB H196B:** The IB H196B course must be sponsored by an IB faculty member, though the research may be in any biology lab. *If working in a non-IB lab, please visit the IB USSO by the 4<sup>th</sup> week of classes to be assigned a faculty sponsor who will be the official instructor of record.*
